WE NEED CLINICAL COACHES! -

Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center School of Nursing is looking for qualified BSNs to assume the role of Clinical Coach in local hospitals to assist Second Degree BSN and Veteran to BSN students in obtaining their BSN. The one-year, Accelerated BSN Program is web-based utilizing preceptor and nurse educator oversight in the student's own communities in Abilene, Amarillo, Austin/Hill Country, Dallas, Lubbock, Odessa, and San Antonio.

WHAT IS A CLINICAL COACH? -

This preceptor model allows the student to have individual attention for their clinical experiences and a one-on-one mentored relationship. The student will spend up to 24 hours per week with the Clinical Coach in the Coach's workplace. This educational program and prescribed weekly clinical objectives developed by course faculty assures that clinical experiences follow objectives congruent with BSN education and the associated course material. TTUHSC faculty oversee the student's progress in the hospital setting and facilitate the mentor/mentee relationship.

WHAT WILL YOU NEED TO APPLY?

- Minimum of a BSN degree preferred
- Current licensure as a registered nurse in the State of Texas
- A minimum of 2 years of hospital experience as a BSN-prepared nurse
- Written or verbal recommendation for the coach role from the nurse manager
- A signed agreement of willingness to work with one specific student for the duration of the 12 month program
